

## IS CAPITALISM FAILING AMERICA? CAMPUS EDITION SWEEPSTAKES

### OFFICIAL RULES

**NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN.**

**A PURCHASE OR SURVEY COMPLETION DOES NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING.**

**1. AGREEMENT TO OFFICIAL RULES** - Participation in the “Is Capitalism Failing America? Campus Edition” Sweepstakes (the “Sweepstakes”) constitutes each entrant’s full and unconditional agreement to these Official Rules and the decisions of the Sponsor, which are final and binding in all matters related to the Sweepstakes.

**2. PROMOTION PERIOD** - Sweepstakes begins at 10:00:00 AM Eastern Time (“ET”) on February 24, 2026 and ends at 11:59:59 PM ET on March 6, 2026 (the “Promotion Period”).

**3. PROMOTION LOCATION & AUDIENCE** - The Sweepstakes will be promoted primarily on the following campuses: Drury University (Springfield, MO); Missouri University of Science and Technology (Rolla, MO); and University of Georgia (Athens, GA) and is limited to full-time and part-time students enrolled at those Universities.

**4. ELIGIBILITY** - The Sweepstakes is open to legal residents of the United States, excluding residents of New York and Florida, who are at least eighteen (18) years of age and enrolled as full or part-time students at either Drury University, Missouri University of Science and Technology or University of Georgia (“University/Universities”) as of the start of the Promotion Period.

Participants must provide a valid name and university-issued (.edu) email address to enter. Sponsor reserves the right to verify student enrollment status prior to awarding a prize.

Employees, officers, directors, contractors, agents, and affiliates of The Foundation for Economic Education, Inc. (the “Sponsor”), Exposure Marketing & Promotion (“Administrator”) and its promotional partners, as well as their immediate family members and household members, are not eligible to participate.

Void in New York, Florida and where prohibited by law. All applicable federal, state, and local laws apply.

**5. HOW TO ENTER** – There are two (2) ways to enter: (1) Online Entry - Participants may use a smart device or computer to enter by completing the official online survey at <https://fee.org/is-capitalism-failing-america>. Follow all onscreen instructions to complete the survey/online entry in its entirety and submit so it is received during the Promotion Period. The answers to the Survey will have no effect on a participant’s ability to enter or win. Upon completion of the Survey, the participant will be invited to complete the entry form in its entirety and submit to receive one (1) Sweepstakes entry (the “Sweepstakes Entry”). (2) Email Entry – Participants may enter the Sweepstakes without completing the survey by sending an email with your name, address, university-provided email address (.edu) and telephone number with the words “Is Capitalism Failing America? Campus Edition Sweepstakes Entry” on the subject line to [SweepsEntry@emipromo.com](mailto:SweepsEntry@emipromo.com). To qualify for the Grand Prize Drawing, any Online or Email Entry must be received by 11:59:59 PM ET on March 6, 2026. **Regardless of entry method, there is a limit: one (1) entry per person for the entire Promotion Period.**

The Sponsor will not accept responsibility for Entries that are corrupted, not successfully completed or transmitted, lost, mislaid, damaged or delayed in transit, regardless of cause, including, for example, as a

result of any equipment failure, technical malfunction, systems, satellite, network, server, website, computer hardware or software failure of any kind.

Any attempt by an Entrant to obtain more Entries than stipulated in these Official Rules by using multiple/different email accounts, identities, or any other methods will void that Entrant's Entries, and that Entrant will be disqualified. Use of scripts, macros, or any other automated system to participate or subvert the process is prohibited and will result in disqualification. In the event of an identity dispute, the Entry will be considered made by the registered holder or owner of the email address account used for entering the Sweepstakes. A potential winner may be required to show proof of being the authorized holder of the email account. Neither Sponsor nor Administrator is responsible for lost, late, misdirected, illegible, incomplete or delayed Entries or responsible for a third party's failure to act in accordance with Sponsor's instructions pertaining to Sweepstakes implementation. Proof of sending or submission will not be deemed to be proof of receipt by the Sponsor. All Entries and requests become Sponsor's property and will not be returned or acknowledged.

**6. ONE (1) GRAND PRIZE:** \$10,000 USD monetary award. Prize winner will receive prize as a check or direct deposit, as determined by Sponsor. Winner will be responsible for providing any information reasonably required to facilitate prize award. No prize substitutions are permitted.

**7. ODDS OF WINNING:** Odds of winning depend on the total number of eligible entries received during the Sweepstakes Period.

**8. WINNER SELECTION & NOTIFICATION:** On or about March 9, 2026, one (1) potential winner will be randomly selected from among all eligible entries received during the Sweepstakes Period. Drawing will be conducted by Administrator, an independent judging organization whose decisions are final. The winner is considered a potential winner pending verification of their eligibility and compliance with these Official Rules. The Administrator's, Sponsor's, and their representative's decisions are final and binding on all matters relating to this Sweepstakes. Potential Grand Prize Winner will be notified by phone and/or email and will be required to complete and return: a) an Affidavit of Eligibility & a Liability/Publicity Release, and b) an IRS W-9 Form (collectively these two forms are referred to hereafter as "Prize Documents") to the Sweepstakes Administrator within five (5) business days from the date of notification. If a prize notification and/or any portion of the Prize Documents are returned as undeliverable, or if a winner cannot accept or receive the Prize for any reason, or he/she is not in compliance with these Official Rules, the corresponding prize will be forfeited and, at Sponsor's discretion, the forfeited prize will be awarded to an alternate winner in a separate random drawing consisting of all non-winning eligible Entries received. All fees, federal, state, local, sales and income taxes or other expenses relating to the use, acceptance and possession of prize are the sole responsibility of each winner. Except where prohibited by law, entry and acceptance of prize constitute permission for Sponsor and its agents and licensees to, at their discretion, contact and subsequently use each winner's name, prize won, hometown, likeness, video tape, photographs, and statements for purposes of advertising, promotion and publicity (including online posting) in any and all media now or hereafter known throughout the world in perpetuity, without additional compensation, notification or permission.

**9. LIABILITY RELEASE:** Entrants agree to these Official Rules and the decisions of the Sweepstakes Administrator and the Sponsor, and release the Sponsor, its parent company, subsidiaries, affiliates, retailers, distributors, advertising and promotion agencies and any other individual or company involved in the development or execution of the Sweepstakes, as well as the employees, officers, directors and agents of each, from all claims and liability relating to their participation, acceptance, use, misuse of a prize. Winners assume all liability for any injury or damage caused or claimed to be caused, by participation in this Sweepstakes or use or redemption of any prize won. The Sponsor is not responsible

for any typographical or other error in the printing of the offer, administration of the Sweepstakes or in the announcement of prizes.

**10. DISPUTE RESOLUTION:** The parties each agree to finally settle all disputes only through arbitration; provided, however, the Sponsor shall be entitled to seek injunctive or equitable relief in the state and federal courts in the State of Georgia, and any other court with jurisdiction over the parties. In arbitration, there is no judge or jury, and review is limited. The arbitrator's decision and award is final and binding, with limited exceptions, and judgment on the award may be entered in any court with jurisdiction. The parties agree that, except as set forth above, any claim, suit, action or proceeding arising out of or relating to this Sweepstakes shall be resolved solely by binding arbitration before a sole arbitrator under the streamlined Arbitration Rules Procedures of JAMS Inc. ("JAMS") or any successor to JAMS. In the event JAMS is unwilling or unable to set a hearing date within fourteen (14) days of the filing of a "Demand for Arbitration", then either party can elect to have the arbitration administered by the American Arbitration Association ("AAA") or any other mutually agreeable arbitration administration service. If an in-person hearing is required, then it will take place in the State of Georgia. The federal or state law that applies to these Official Rules will also apply during the arbitration. Disputes will be arbitrated only on an individual basis and will not be consolidated with any other proceedings that involve any claims or controversy of another party, including any class actions; provided, however, if for any reason any court or arbitrator holds that this restriction is unconscionable or unenforceable, then the agreement to arbitrate doesn't apply and the dispute must be brought in a court of competent jurisdiction in the State of Georgia. Sponsor agrees to pay the administrative and arbitrator's fees in order to conduct the arbitration (but specifically excluding any travel or other costs of entrant to attend the arbitration hearing). Either party may, notwithstanding this provision, bring qualifying claims in small claims court.

**11. GENERAL:** The Sponsor is not responsible for: (i) error, omission, interruption, deletion, defect, delay in operations or transmission, theft or destruction or unauthorized access to or alterations of entry materials, or for technical, network, telephone equipment, electronic, computer, hardware or software malfunctions of any kind, or inaccurate transmission of or failure to receive Entry information by Sponsor on account of technical problems or traffic congestion on the Internet or at any website or any combination thereof; or (ii) any injury or damage to entrant's or any other person's computer related to or resulting from participating in the Sweepstakes. By participating in the Sweepstakes, you (i) agree to be bound by these Official Rules, including all eligibility requirements, and (ii) agree to be bound by the decisions of Sponsor and the independent judging organization, which are final and binding in all matters relating to the Sweepstakes. Failure to comply with these Official Rules may result in disqualification from the Sweepstakes. Sponsor reserves the right to: (i) permanently disqualify from any sweepstakes it sponsors any person it believes has intentionally violated these Official Rules; and (ii) withdraw or cancel the Sweepstakes if it becomes technically corrupted, (including if a computer virus or system malfunction inalterably impairs its ability to conduct the Sweepstakes), and to select winner(s) from among all eligible Entries received prior to withdrawal. **CAUTION: ANY ATTEMPT TO DELIBERATELY DAMAGE ANY WEBSITE OR UNDERMINE THE LEGITIMATE OPERATION OF THE SWEEPSTAKES IS A VIOLATION OF CRIMINAL AND CIVIL LAWS.
